
I'd like to tell you about the people we serve, for they are remarkably diverse.

What they share is a desire for the end of their life—for each day remaining—to be peaceful, painless and meaningful. We are honored that they put their trust in Harbor Hospice.

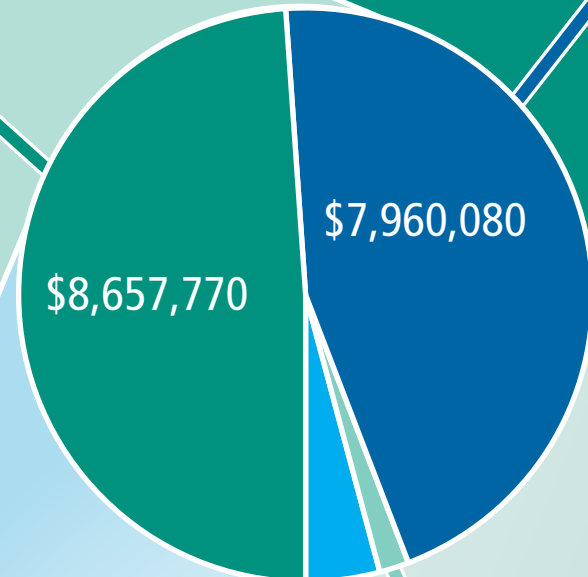
