The next morning, hundreds of sailing fans along the shores of Muskegon Lake will gather for the **10th Annual Harbor Hospice Regatta** at the [Muskegon Yacht Club](#). This hugely popular race is part of the National Hospice Regatta Alliance ([hospiceregattas.org](http://hospiceregattas.org)) that has raised over \$23 million dollars for hospice services across the country. West Michigan sailors love this race, and in the past 10 years have raised over \$300,000 to support local hospice care. A wonderful picnic will be available for \$10 per lunch.

**Open to the public**, families throughout the western Michigan lakeshore communities are invited to attend the annual Harbor Hospice Regatta. Not only will guests be able to enjoy a beautiful view of sailboats on the lake, but they are also invited to participate in the family-oriented picnic as well as mingle and listen to vinyl played by Black Circle Radio. The event, which first began in 2008, will take place on Saturday, August 19, at the Muskegon Yacht Club.
